Note: Students should keep a supply all year ~ it's cheaper to buy supplies now and keep them at home to stock up!

## A Note About Lockers:

If the student plans on decorating the inside of his/her locker, only themes and artists that are appropriate may be used. Only easily removable items are permitted. Lockers are the property of the school and no expectation of privacy is implied.

Students are expected to keep lockers organized and are responsible for them. Periodic locker checks will occur during the school year.

Every middle school must keep belongings in the locker and *keep a lock on the locker*.

8<sup>th</sup> grade needs to purchase ONE padlock. 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grades need TWO padlocks. It might be wise to purchase an additional lock when they are on sale at school supply time.

All combinations must be given to the homeroom teacher on the first day of school. The students *should not* share their combination with friends!

Cell phones, only if a parent feels that the student needs to bring them to school, must be dropped off in the office and each morning and are NOT allowed to be in the locker. The student is responsible for picking up the phone & signing it out in the afternoon before leaving.

Cell phones are not the responsibility of Calvary.

NO ELECTRONICS in school (iPods, tablets, etc) unless required by a teacher
